

CODE OF ETHICS MBTCNE

This Code is established in accordance with the objectives of the MBTCNE to protect and advance the interests of the Miniature Bull Terrier and to provide guidelines for responsible ownership and conduct amongst its members.

GENERAL CONDUCT:

Members will:

- provide and maintain the best possible standards of health, cleanliness, safety, and care of their Miniature Bull Terrier as recommended by the AKC.
- comply with the rules and regulations of the AKC, the Constitution and Bylaws of MBTCNE and the Code of ethics of the MBTCNE.
- demonstrate conduct that exhibits good sportsmanship, whether at shows, or host hotels. https://images.akc.org/pdf/AKC code of sportsmanship.pdf
- refrain from the use of malicious, slanderous or discrediting statements against another breeder, specific kennel, dog, club member, Miniature Bull Terrier Club of the Northeast, Judges, etc... on any public forum (including social media) and will promote an environment free of harassment and discrimination.
- use only the prescribed method in addressing club concerns and issues to the BOD as designated in the Bylaws or Standing Rules.

HEALTH

As a regional club under the auspices of the MBTCA the MBTCNE recommends that our members follow the guidelines regarding health set fourth by the Parent club MBTCA.NET

DISCIPLINE

Implicit in membership in the MBTCNE is the understanding and full acceptance of the Code of Ethics as presented. As an American Kennel Club ("AKC") and Miniature Bull Terrier specialty club, violations of Rules and Regulations may result in discipline as set forth in Article VI of the MBTCNE Constitution and Bylaws up to and including suspension.
